- Five different Kata (ZNKR) in ascending order. Free choice

### IKKYU:

- Examination has to be done **with Sageo**
- Five different Kata (ZNKR) in ascending order. Free choice

### SHODAN – SANDAN:

- Examination with Sageo
- Five different Kata (ZNKR) in ascending order. Free choice

### YONDAN – GODAN:

- Examination with Sageo
- First Kata must be Koryu
- The four ZNKR Kata will be fixed by grading panel leadership
- Time limit of 6 minutes is possible

### DEAD LINE FOR GRADING:

- 4 weeks before the grading
- Registrations which will be send after dead line can't be accepted
- All registrations have to be send together with the answered grading questions
